ABSTRACT

Our working, volunteer and political relationships are tempted every day by ethical dilemmas that challenge our governing truths. We are familiar with facing policy choices for standards of rural public service and investments in hard rural infrastructure, like building hospices or bridges, but often we forget the flipside of the policy that ensures a healthy rate of return from our decisions.
